## Guidelines for captive bolt euthanasia of cattle and calves.

- An authorized personnel will make the decision to humanely euthanize the animal that is non-ambulatory.
- 2 Mark the animal's head from horn or poll to the **outside** corner of opposite eye.
- 3 Load the captive bolt gun.
- Place the muzzle of the captive bolt gun against the animal's head at a 90 angle on the middle of the 'X'.
- Pull the trigger on the captive bolt gun.
- 6 Check the animal's eye for a corneal reflex.
- Wait five (5) minutes and recheck the eye for a corneal reflex. If the reflex is present, repeat steps 3-7.
- If no corneal reflex is present, the euthanasia was successful. Record animal on Euthanasia Log Form.
- Dispose of carcass as premise protocol directs.
