

Outagamie County Small Animal Committee Educational Scholarship Program

Overview

This Scholarship fund was created to benefit members/leaders enrolled in the Poultry and/or Rabbit projects as well as adults that are chaperoning an educational trip or event. There are requirements that need to be met to take advantage of this scholarship and all applications are subject to review as well as availability of funds.

Application Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements to be considered eligible for the scholarship.

1. Applicant must be a current member/leader, or parent of a current member of the Outagamie County Poultry and/or Rabbit project.
2. Applicant must have attended a project mandatory meeting during the past 12 months.
3. Applicant must be in good standing with the Small Animal Committee.
4. Requests must be received by the Scholarship Committee two weeks prior to the show or event.
5. Applicant must attend the event in person.
6. The Small Animal Committee has final discretion in the approval process for applications.

Scholarship Benefits

The scholarship fund may cover expenses related to an educational event based on the information below.

1. Animal entry fees will be covered at 50%
 - a. Maximum reimbursement is \$50 per event per applicant
 - b. Applicants will not be reimbursed for more than 3 events in a 12 month period
2. For events over 200 miles roundtrip, mileage will be reimbursed
 - a. Reimbursement is 25 cents per mile per event
 - b. Mileage reimbursement will be divided by all vehicles going to the event
 - c. Maximum mileage reimbursement is \$80 per event
 - d. Mileage will only be reimbursed for 3 events in a 12 month period per applicant

Application Process

The application process is outlined below.

1. Complete the Application form attached, only complete applications will be considered.
2. Reimbursement will be made after the event when the following documentation is received:
 - a. Copy of the entry form
 - b. Copy of the check paying entry fees OR a paid receipt
 - c. 200 to 500 word essay summarizing the event, including what you learned, by attending the event. This is due within 3 weeks of the event end date.
