Junior Show Information

Entry Deadlines | June 6

- **Paper entries** must include YQCA Certification, Registration Forms and Health Certificate.
- **Entry Fee: \$10 per head**, no charge for showmanship

Entry Process:

- Participation in the Wisconsin State Fair Junior animal shows is open to any youth 12-19 years of age as of January 1st of the current year.
- Junior exhibitors must be a member in good standing with an approved youth organization by March 1 in order to be eligible to participate in Junior Fair programs.
- Policies for entry substitutions will be located in the respective entry information.
- After the June 6 entry deadline, Wisconsin State Fair will verify participant eligibility with the respective approved youth organization and local County Extension Agent or Fair Boards.

Exhibitors will be able to send in payment for their **Youth Center fees** with their entries (located directly on the Entry Forms) or with Junior online entries (the Youth Center is listed under the “Department” options).

State Fair Updates

- For a member to be in good standing with the Wisconsin State Fair he or she must attend at least 3 educational experiences. The following are classified as educational experiences:
 - Fitting Clinics
 - Judging Workshops/Contests
 - Attend Breed/Livestock Sales
 - Speaking Contests
 - Project Meetings
 - Skillathon Workshops
 - Quiz Bowls
 - Recreation/Social activities may only be counted as an educational activity once
 - Organizational meetings (monthly, committee, conventions and conferences) may only be counted as an educational activity once
 - Exhibiting at Livestock shows may only be counted as an educational activity once
- Wisconsin State Fair reserves the right to audit a member or organization’s compliance with these requirements at any time. Evidence of non-compliance may disqualify a member and an organization from current or future Wisconsin State Fair Junior Fair participation.
