

2019 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS
*OUTAGAMIE HOME AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION
*SHIRLEY RICHARDSON and ANY OTHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The Outagamie Extension Association of Home and Community Education awards two \$750 scholarships annually. Both scholarships are available to a student who is completing their senior year of high school or student continuing education on a full-time basis at either a college or technical school. The candidate for the memorial scholarships must be the son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, or niece/nephew of an active member of the Outagamie Extension Association of Home and Community Education or must be a current Outagamie County 4-H member. Residents of Outagamie County, and Wisconsin will be given first preference. A candidate will only be eligible to receive one of the \$750 scholarships. Scholarships are awarded one time per individual.
2. The scholarship is to be used for any accredited course in any college, university or accredited course at a technical college. This scholarship will be based on academics, financial needs, citizenship and leadership qualities.
3. Students who have averaged grades of "B" or above, who possess qualities for satisfactory advanced studies, and who meet the above qualifications may apply. Please include a transcript of your last semester's study.
4. The application, accompanied by a 100 or more word essay entitled, "How will my education benefit me personally and how would I be making a difference in the community?" should be received by March 1 to the Family Living Educator, 3365 West Brewster Street, Appleton, WI 54914 (Not postmarked by March 1. There is a drop box at the UW-Extension office for those who cannot mail it in time to meet the deadline.)
5. Two written letters of recommendation are required. At least one of the letters must be from the high school principal, a teacher/advisor, or counselor. The other letter is not limited to teachers or school related; it can be from a coach, mentor, 4-H leader, etc. The letters of recommendation must be included with the application form in a sealed envelope that has been initialized on the seal of the envelope.
6. The treasurer of the Outagamie County HCE will pay \$750 to each recipient at the end of the first semester upon receipt of an official 1st semester grade transcript. It is the responsibility of the recipient to submit the official 1st semester grade transcript to the Family Living Educator, Outagamie County UW-Extension, 3365 W. Brewster St., Appleton, WI 54914.
7. In the event that the applicant does not follow through with their plans for school, the scholarship will be awarded to the alternate. If the alternate does not qualify, the applicant next in line will be chosen.
8. The award of the two scholarships will be announced at the Outagamie Extension Association of Home and Community Education Recognition Banquet, which is usually held in spring. The winners will be invited to attend this banquet to receive the scholarship.
