Come and learn from Katie Coyne, owner of Mill Wheel Farm Dairy Show Clinics! You will learn how to show, fit, feed, prepare, judge and develop show-winning animals. Last year over 1,000 youth and judges attended her clinics to learn successful practices for showing cattle. Pandemic guidelines will be followed.

Cost: \$15 per youth for clinic (no clinic charge for adults), **\$6 for lunch per person** (youth and adults). **All costs pre-paid using the registration form below.** Subway sandwich with chips and cookie or bring your own bag lunch. Water will be provided by Cheryl O'Connell.

Registration deadline: April 19. Minimum of 25 participants, maximum of 40. Return the form below to Extension Outagamie County, Attn: Dairy Fitting Clinic, 3365 W Brewster St, Appleton, WI 54914.

Training starts promptly at 9:30 am. Please arrive with your animal by 9:00 am. Bring your project animal to practice fitting and showing practices. Youth are encouraged to bring whites for showmanship. Recognition will be given to the top showman for the day and the most improved for the day. Please wash your animal the night before the clinic and have the head, legs, and body of your animal clipped prior to the clinic. Katie will help with top lines and belly hair. *Notes: Youth who wish to share a calf to work on must arrange this prior to the clinic. No washing of project animals during the clinic.*

Items for youth to bring: Clippers, topline brush, blower, show halter, bag of shavings for bedding, whites, hay, water bucket, fork or shovel for manure, any other supplies needed.
