



FAIR DAYS & TIPS!

Now is a great time to start planning for the 2025 fair! For any breeding birds, you'll want growouts already a month old or older. Make sure you are feeding them a good grower feed, with about 19% protein and 3% fat content. Once they start laying, you'll want to change to a layer feed with 16% protein, 4% fat, and a calcium ratio at about 2.5. This will keep your chickens in the best condition for the fair!
